Standard diagnostic outputs

Names and scope are controlled.

01 Scope and Assumptions Note

Confirms the selected route, diagnostic boundary, evidence basis, exclusions and material assumptions.

02 Decision Route Reconstruction

Reconstructs the route across systems, roles, approvals, overrides and escalation points.

03 Evidence Sufficiency Assessment

Tests whether the available evidence is attributable, decision-relevant and pressure-testable.

04 Authority, Override and Escalation View

Locates formal authority, operational influence, human intervention and escalation capacity.

05 Exposure Findings Matrix

Consolidates material findings, evidential basis, operational significance and relevant limitations.

06 Executive Exposure Report

Documents the reconstructed route, evidence, findings, limitations and practical implications.

07 Board Brief

Provides a concise executive view of material exposure and decisions requiring senior attention.

08 Close-Out and 30-Day Routing Note

Identifies immediate clarification, evidence-preservation and routing priorities; it does not redesign governance.

OPERATING BOUNDARY

The diagnostic examines the reconstructibility, attribution and defensibility of a bounded AI-assisted decision route. It does not certify the organisation, determine legal compliance, audit model performance or assume responsibility for management decisions.

PRECEDENCE AND CHANGE CONTROL

Where public materials use abbreviated language, this definition governs unless a signed proposal expressly states otherwise. Any change to product, object, duration, format, fee, limits or outputs requires a new controlled version.
